**Students Must Bring:** mask, small paint brush to apply leafing adhesive, heat tool or hair dryer, wood burning tool, Dremel type tool if you have one, a drum sander attachment, gloves for ink dying. I will have some extra tools for class use.

**Instructor will Supply:** gourd, wood bottoms, dyes, metal leafing, and all other supplies.

This design will encircle the whole gourd. The student will learn to carve two relief figures with a combination smooth and stippled background. The student will learn how to trace a design, carve the outline, remove the gourd shell, smooth and stipple the surface, cut filigree into the background. The gourd, designs, and frame will be dyed.

**Students Must Bring:** Students Must Bring: Foredom, Optima, Dremel or similar tools w/flexible extension, 1/8 and 3/32 collets or adjustable chuck, dust masks, burr to remove gourd shell, thick wall gourd 5" - 10" diameter. The gourd should be cut and cleaned and not painted on the inside, heat gun or blow dryer, sanding drum, favorite burrs, small power sander, sanding sticks or other sanding tools.

**Instructor will Supply:** for class use - not for sale - burrs / round, flat saw, filigree, inverted cone, various sanding, stains, inks, dyes, heat guns, nitrile gloves, sand shells, glue and toothpicks.
