Class handout will also include other knot work designs. Creating a satin smooth finish and conditioning the gourd to evenly accept ink dyes will also be included in this class.

Students Must Bring: small paint brushes, wood burning tool, heat tool or hair dryer, gloves if you are concerned about stained hands. Some extra tools will be available for class use, but bringing your own helps the class keep moving.

Instructor will Supply: prepared gourds, all other necessary supplies and handouts.

After students transfer and wood burn patterns, they will Epoxy Sculpt the dragonfly body. Glass may be used either in the body or as the head. They will then paint (blue, green or purple) the gourd, paint the dragonfly and sew on the philodendron rim.

Students Must Bring: cleaned open gourd (7-8" diameter, 4" opening), dust mask, wood burner, carver with small ball bit.

Instructor will Supply: tutorial, inks, paints, Epoxy sculpt, dichroic glass and all other materials.

Students will learn to cut, clean and paint a pumpkin gourd that make a really cute candy dish.

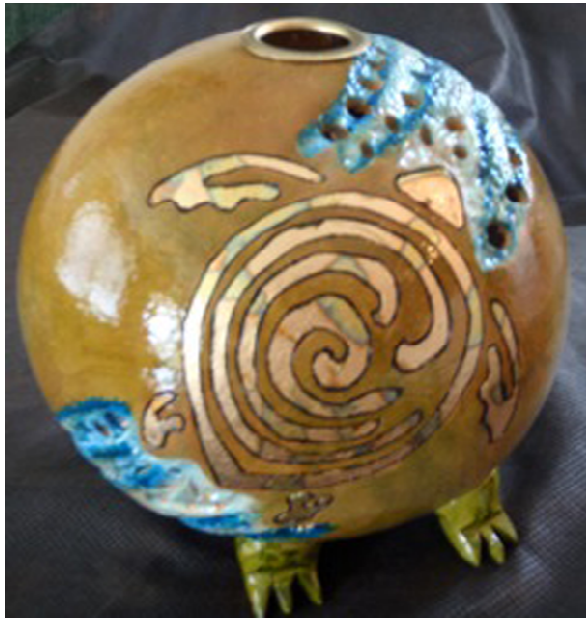
Students Must Bring:

6. Apron.

Instructor will Supply: all other supplies, including the cut gourds, paints, patterns and decorative finishing items. I will have some cleaning tools to share.

Students will take a cleaned cannon ball gourd and create an oil lamp with gold leaf and fret work. The student will wood burn the sea turtle in preparation for applying gold leaf. They will then wood carve and create the fret work wave around the turtle. The gourd will be stained using alcohol dye. Quickwood feet will be applied to stabilize the gourd.

Students Must Bring: Wood burner with spear tip, wood carver with assortment of wood carving bits. Set of Micro Brushes, heat tool or hair dryer, mask, water basin, pen or pencil, apron, foam plates, paper towels, hand wipes, 3/4" flat brush, #2 script liner.

Instructor will Supply: cannon ball gourd, Quickwood, Adirondack alcohol ink, Mona Lisa Copper or Gold Leaf, adhesive and sealer. Oil vial insert with brass ring, Xacto knife, super glue, foam plates, toothbrush or toothpicks, paper towels, Press & Seal, gloves, turtle pattern, hand sanitizer/handi-wipes, Microbrush, Krylon Crystal Clear Glaze, foam brushes.

Students will learn several basic wood burning techniques, including outlining, shading, feathering and temperature control. They will have an opportunity to practice these before burning on their gourd. After burning, inking and waxing their gourds, they will learn an easy-to-master weaving technique. Students should have ample time to complete the weaving in the allotted class time. However, if they do not finish the weaving, they should have enough practice with the technique to complete their gourd at home.

Students Must Bring: an adjustable temperature wood burner and a writing tip. Bring any other wood burning tips you may have and want to experiment with if time allows.

Instructor will supply: all other supplies, including but not limited to a cleaned cut, sanded drilled gourd, gourd shards for practice, instruction packet with a photo of the finished project, pattern, Press & Seal, inks, micro brushes, wax sealer, waxed linen and rawhide strips in a variety of colors, tapestry needles, etc.
